G.S.R. 924.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution, the President hereby makes the following rules further to amend the All India Radio (Class I Posts) Recruitment Rules, 1963, published with the Notification of the Government of India in the Ministry of Information and Broadcasting No. G.S.R. 24 dated the 23rd December, 1963, namely:—

- 1. These rules may be called the All India Radio (Class I Posts) Recruitment Second Amendment Rules, 1964.
 - (a) in the entries against Serial number 2.-
 - (i) in column 3, for figures "50", the figures "51" shall be substituted;
 - (ii) in column 8. after the existing entries, the following entry shall be inserted, namely:—

"Qualifications relaxable at the discretion of the Union Public Service Commission in the case of candidates otherwise well qualified.";

(b) in the entries against Serial number 3, in column 12, for the words "ordinary not exceeding", the words "not ordinarily to exceed" shall be substituted.
