

**MINISTRY OF INFORMATION AND BROADCASTING**

New Delhi, the 9th January, 1981

G.S.R. 99.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution, the President hereby makes the following rules further to amend the All India Radio (Group 'D' posts) Recruitment Rules, 1964, namely :—

1. (1) These rules may be called the All India Radio Group 'D' posts Recruitment (Amendment) Rules, 1981.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. In the Schedule to the All India Radio (Group 'D' posts) Recruitment Rules, 1964.

(1) after rule 4 the following rule shall be inserted, namely :

4A. Liability of persons appointed as peons to undergo training as Home Guards.

Notwithstanding anything contained in these rules every person appointed as a Peon under these rules shall undergo training as a Home Guard for a period of three years; provided that the Commandant General Home Guards, may having regard to the performance and standard of training achieved by any person during the period of training reduce such period to two years.

(2) for serial no. 6 and the entries relating thereto, the following serial number and entries shall be substituted, namely :—
