

PRASAR BHARATI CERTIFICATE PRACTICAL TRAINING COURSE FOR JOURNALISM PURSUING STUDENTS

News Services Division of All India Radio, News Broadcasting House, Parliament Street, New Delhi conducts four weeks Certificate training Course for Journalism pursuing students during summer every year.

DETAILS OF THE TRAINING

1. Name of the course :- Certificate training Course for Journalism pursuing Students
2. Duration :- Four weeks
3. Fees :- Rs. 4720/- (4000 + 18 % GST)
4. Who can apply :- Students pursuing diploma or degree course in journalism/Mass Communication
5. Documents required For applying :-
Resume with attached photo
Forwarding letter for training from the college
Draft of Rs. 4720/- in f/o DG (N), NSD, AIR, New Delhi
A copy of I-Card
6. Criteria of selection For the training :- After scrutiny of applications.
7. Batch size :- 15-20 students in the batch
8. Coordination Meeting :- A meeting of nodal officers of Newsroom, Talks and Current Affairs Unit, Reporting Unit, social media Cell and IT Unit may be kept for coordination and chalking out the schedule and assessment for the interns.
9. Study material To be provided :- A folder is given to students carrying the following items :-

A brief about NSD, AIR
A note pad and a pen
Pool copies, unedited stories of news agencies and other reporting excursive may be given for practice by the resource person.
10. Resource Person :- A panel of experts having vast experience in Editing and Reporting for Radio
11. Schedule :- Detailed schedule of 3 weeks training is worked out in the coordination meeting of GNR, HNR, NF, Social Media Cell, Reporting, and Talks and Current Affairs ahead of starting the training.

On the first day two lectures on reporting and editing for Radio respectively is given by experts selected from the panel. Duration of each lectures may be 1:30 hrs each.

The interns are attached to GNR,HNR, Reporting NF, Social Media Cell and Talks and Current Affairs in Small groups in rotation in day and evening shifts for 3 Weeks. They will be attached to officers or desks in different units for on the job training. The schedule will be chalked out during the coordination meeting.

During the first three days of the last week i.e. 4th Week, Practical exercises are given to the interns by the expert Engaged for the job. On the 4th day debriefing is be done by the Senior officers and on the 5th day valedictory function will be held to give away the certificates.

12. Deputing a Person for training in Each unit :-

Interns are attached to an officer/desk in each unit and they perform the task assigned to them by the concerned officer/ desk. A report on the task performed at each desk/unit is given by the interns individually at the end of training.

13. Evaluation of Bulletins/ Features.

The expert deputed for the practical exercise will evaluate the performance of the interns and submit a Report to Dir(Trg.).

14. Certificates :-

Training Completion certificate is given to the interns on the last day of training during a valedictory function.

15. Feedback :-

Interns are asked to give their suggestion in details Which are considered for improving future training programs.
