Code No. 02: 1. Written Test for General Knowledge and Current Events as well as knowledge of local language..

2.Voice Test and Interview to assess suitability for radio news.

Code No. 03: 1.Written Test to assess journalistic and professional capability as well as knowledge of local language.

2. Interview to assess overall personality and suitability for radio news.

Code No. 04: 1. Written Test for General Knowledge and current events.

2. Practical Proficiency Test in computer Operations for various audio formats.

Code No. 05 : 1 Written Test to assess journalistic and professional capability as well as knowledge of editing and publishing information on websites/ social media.

2. Interview to assess overall personality and suitability for radio news.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. The applicants may note that working on casual assignment basis for RNU, AIR, Kolkata will not confer any right for regularization of services in this organization. The booking will be offered from time to time on the basis of the requirements of the organization and will not normally exceed six days in a month. The candidates are required to deposit application processing fee (**non-refundable**) at the following rates, along with the applications through **Bank Draft payable in favour of the DDO, All India Radio, Kolkata.**
 - a) General Category : 300/-
 - b) SC/ST/OBC : 225/-
2. The applicant applying for more than one category, is required to submit separate applications along with the separate processing fee.
3. Candidates working in Govt./Autonomous bodies should obtain a “No Objection Certificate” from their respective employers.
4. Application should reach the Sr. Administrative Officer, All India Radio, Akashvani Bhawan, Eden Gardens, Kolkata-700001. on or before **27.07.2021 (5 p.m.)**. The envelope containing the applications in the prescribed format should be super scribed with category of application i.e. “**Application for Editor (Bengali)/ News Reader-cum-Translator (Bengali)/ Reporter (Bengali)/ Broadcast Assistant/ Web Editor in RNU, AIR, Kolkata**”. Applications received after the prescribed date and time will not be considered. For any late receipt or non-receipt of the applications, this Division shall not be held responsible and no further correspondence in this regard shall be entertained.
5. The list of eligible candidates will be put on the vacancies section of NSD, AIR website www.newsonair.gov.in or www.prasarbharati.gov.in/vacancies/. The exact time, date, venue etc. for the written examination will be put on NSD:AIR website. All the applicants are requested to constantly check the website on regular basis after the closing date for the submission of the application. Call letter for written test and interview will be sent to the selected candidates on mail.
6. The results of the written test in respect of the qualifying candidates as well as the date for the schedule of interview will be put on the website. The final results will also be available on vacancies section of the NSD:AIR website www.newsonair.gov.in or www.prasarbharati.gov.in/vacancies/
7. The applicants are required to submit their applications in the prescribed format given in the advertisement only. Non submission of proofs of relevant documents in prescribed format, will render the application liable for rejection at scrutiny stage. There will be no further correspondence in this regard.
8. The applicants may please note that written test, voice test & interview will be held in Kolkata. No TA/DA will be admissible to the candidates attending written test, voice test & interview.
