(1) News Editor / Reporter (Malayalam)

Essential Qualification:

- ; Graduate from a recognized University
- ; Degree **OR** Post Graduate Diploma in Journalism with a duration of atleast one year from a recognized University/Institution **OR** 5-year experience in reporting/editing work in print/electronic media
- ; Proficiency in Malayalam language
- ; Knowledge of basic computer applications

Desirable qualification:

Experience of journalistic work in Radio/TV (for degree/diploma holders in Journalism)

Nature of Job

; Preparation of prime time news bulletins which involves editing of news and compilation

(2) Newsreader-cum-Translator (Malayalam)

Essential Qualification:

- ; Graduate from a recognized University
- ; Proficiency in Malayalam language
- ; Having a voice of good quality suited to broadcasting
- ; Knowledge of basic computer applications
- ; Must have Malayalam typing skill

Desirable qualification:

; Experience of journalistic work in Radio/TV

Nature of Job:

Translation from English to Malayalam and vice-versa and presenting the news bulletins and news-based programmes

Method of Selection for News Editors / Reporters (Malayalam):

The Selection procedure comprises two stages (1) written test (2) interview. Each test carries 100 marks. The written test will be to assess the candidate's journalistic and professional capability; as well as knowledge of the language concerned (Malayalam). The minimum qualifying marks in the written test will be 50. Those qualifying in written test will be interviewed to assess their overall personality and suitability for radio news by a Selection Committee. The Selection Committee will recommend candidates securing 50 marks or above in the interview for approval for empanelment, which will be given by Principal Director General (News).

Method of Selection for Newsreader-cum-translators:

The Selection procedure comprises two stages (1) written test (2) voice test & interview to assess the professional competence and knowledge of the candidate in Malayalam and English. Each test carries 100 marks. The written test will seek to assess a candidate's journalistic and professional capability as well as

knowledge of the language concerned (Malayalam). The minimum qualifying marks in the written test will be 50. Candidates securing 50 marks and above in the written examination will be called for Voice test to assess voice quality, modulation, diction, pronunciation and accent. Voice test may be followed by interview to assess the suitability of the candidate for radio news by a Selection Committee. The Selection Committee will recommend candidates securing 50 marks and above in the voice test & interview, for approval for empanelment, which will be given by Principal Director General (News).

Written Test

The written test consists of descriptive type questions on general knowledge and current affairs, news drafting skills for radio, passages for translation from English to Malayalam and vice-versa etc. The duration of the written test will be three hours.

Age:

Not less than 21 years and not more than 50 years (as on the last date of advertisement)
