Subject: - Steps to avoid Contempt cases - Instructions reg.

Attention is invited to Prasar Bharati Secretariat's communication of even number dated 15th July, 2019 whereby detailed instructions were issued regarding steps to be taken to avoid contempt cases by the Directorates in their respective headquarters and the regional and field offices across the country (copy enclosed at **Annexure-I** for ready reference).

- 2. Pursuant to these instructions, the Directorate General of All India Radio has prepared a list of Field Level Nodal officers posted in the Regional Offices/Stations/Kendras. A list of Field Level Nodal officers is annexed as **Annexure-II** to this letter.
- 3. As detailed in Prasar Bharati Secretariat's communication of even number dated 15th July, 2019, these Field Level Nodal officers shall undertake the following responsibilities –
- (i) Watch the **Cause Lists** of the High Court(s) and the bench(s) of Central Administrative Tribunal **on daily basis** for cases filed against CEO, Prasar Bharati, Director General of All India Radio/Doordarshan [including DG(News & CA) and DG:NSD], CCW, AIR and/or Heads of AIR Stations/DD Kendras (including RNUs) and;
- (ii) Maintain close liaison with the concerned Central Government Counsels or Counsel empanelled (or specifically engaged, if any) and contact them for the outcome of the cases listed every day (fresh as well as ongoing cases), including orders/interim orders passed by the Courts/Tribunals alongwith OA/WP and connected applications in such cases.

(iii) Promptly inform simultaneously through e-mail the concerned Nodal Officers (Legal) of the respective Directorates for further needful action and monitoring at their end on priority basis. Copies of such intimations shall also be sent to the Nodal Officer (Legal) in Prasar Bharati Secretariat for record and overall supervision. Names, designations, contact numbers and e-mail id of the Nodal Officers (Legal) of DG:AIR, DG:DD and Prasar Bharati Secretariat are indicated below:

Subject: - Steps to avoid Contempt cases - Instructions reg.

Of late it has been observed that there is increase in Contempt Petitions filed in various benches of Central Administrative Tribunals/High Courts. This prima-facie indicates that the directions passed by Court are not implemented or challenged within stipulated time. In some cases, it is observed that OA is disposed of at the admission stage itself with the directions to pass a speaking order or to dispose of the representation of the applicant therein. But even in such cases where the litigation is pivoted around settled policy matters, the speaking orders are not issued in time, not to speak of filing of compliance affidavit in the Tribunal/Court.

- 2. At times, Contempt Notices are issued to the Secretary, MIB and CEO, Prasar Bharati due to non-compliance of simple directions of the Courts/Tribunals. These instances have evoked sharp observations from CEO, Prasar Bharati and the Ministry. CEO, Prasar Bharati has expressed concern on the growing incidences of contempt cases which may be due to missing accountabilities on the part of the officers in dealing with such Tribunal/Court orders. A need has been felt to put in place a system with defined responsibilities and accountabilities for monitoring and handling of the Courts matters.
- 3. The matter has been reviewed in Prasar Bharati Secretariat and the following procedure is reiterated for strict observance by all the Directorates:
- (a) In order to avoid instance of Contempt cases, it is hereby made clear that orders passed by the Courts/Tribunals are to be accorded highest priority. These are either to be implemented in consultation/with the approval of the Government of India, wherever necessary (especially those relating to the service conditions, recruitment rules or pay etc. of the central government employees on deemed deputation or involve expenditure from the

- public exchequer) or have to be challenged at the appropriate level within the prescribed time limit.
- (b) Often the time taken to decide further course of action on court orders exceed the time allowed in the orders. In such cases, it is incumbent on the part of the concerned Directorate to seek more time from the Courts/Tribunals well before the expiry of the prescribed time limit.
- 4. If these simple steps as outlined above are followed in time, there will be fewer occasions for contempt petitions.
- 5. There may be occasions when the orders are passed by the Courts/Tribunal (mostly in places outside Delhi) at the admission stage when Prasar Bharati or any of its subordinate offices arrayed as respondent remain unrepresented by its Counsels or the designated Central Government Counsels accept the Notices on behalf of the respondents (which include MIB and CEO Prasar Bharati). It has been noticed that orders (including interim orders) passed by the Courts/Tribunal along with OA/WP in such cases often do not reach the appropriate authorities in DG:AIR/DG:DD or Prasar Bharati Secretariat.
- 6. In order to handle above situations effectively, it has been decided to put in place a system of Nodal Officers across the country with appropriate responsibilities and accountabilities. Accordingly, it has been decided that DG:AIR shall designate officers of the rank of Administrative Officer or above (as detailed at **ANNEXURE-I**) as Field Level Nodal Officers with following responsibilities
 - (i) Watch the **Cause Lists** of the High Court(s) and the bench(s) of Central Administrative Tribunal on daily basis for cases filed against CEO, Prasar Bharati, Director General of All India Radio/Doordarshan [including DG(News & CA) and DG:NSD), CCW, AIR and/or Heads of AIR Stations/DD Kendras (including RNUs) and;
 - (ii) Maintain close liaison with the concerned Central Government Counsels or Counsel empanelled (or specifically engaged, if any) and contact them for the outcome of the cases listed every day (fresh as well as ongoing cases), including

orders/interim orders passed by the Courts/Tribunals alongwith OA/WP and connected applications in such cases.

- (iii) Promptly inform simultaneously through e-mail the concerned Nodal Officers (Legal) of the respective Directorates (to be communicated by DG:AIR in consultation with DG:DD) for further needful action and monitoring at their end on priority basis. Copies of such intimations shall also be sent to the Nodal Officer (Legal) in Prasar Bharati Secretariat for record and overall supervision (email: aelegalpbs@gmail.com).
- 7. The particulars of the Field Level Nodal Officers designated for this purpose may be furnished to Prasar Bharati Secretariat (Legal Cell) latest by **19.07.2019**.
- 8. Above instructions may be widely circulated in both the Directorates as well as the regional and field offices for strict compliance. Any lapse in this regard shall be viewed seriously including initiation of disciplinary proceedings.
- 9. Modalities for monitoring cases in Labour Courts (CGITs) will be issued separately.
- 10. This issues with the approval of CEO, Prasar Bharati.


