(Department of Food)**ORDER***New Delhi, the 21st September 1966*

G.S.R. 1504.—In exercise of the powers conferred by section 3 of the Essential Commodities Act, 1955 (10 of 1955), the Central Government hereby makes the following Order further to amend the Inter-Zonal Wheat and Wheat Products (Movement Control) Order, 1964, namely:—

1. This Order may be called the Inter-Zonal Wheat and Wheat Products (Movement Control) Third Amendment Order, 1966.

2. In the Inter-Zonal Wheat and Wheat Products (Movement Control) Order, 1964, for the fourth proviso to clause 3, the following shall be substituted, namely:—

“Provided also that it shall be lawful for a person ordinarily residing outside the limits of Zone II (comprising the State of Madhya Pradesh) to take wheat from any place within those limits into his place of residence under and in accordance with a permit issued in that behalf by—

- (a) the Director of Food Supplies, Madhya Pradesh, or the Collector having jurisdiction if such wheat is received by such person as wages in kind for the work done by him within those limits;
- (b) the Government of Madhya Pradesh or by any authority authorized in this behalf by that Government if such wheat is the produce of land owned or cultivated by him in Madhya Pradesh and required for *bona fide* seed purposes or for consumption by himself and the members of his family.”

MINISTRY OF INFORMATION AND BROADCASTING*New Delhi, the 15th September 1966*

G.S.R. 1505.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution, the President hereby makes the following rules further to amend the All India Radio (Class III posts) Recruitments Rules, 1964, published with the notification of the Government of India in the Ministry of Information and Broadcasting No. G.S.R. 1776, dated the 30th November, 1964, namely:—

1. These rules may be called the All India Radio (Class III Posts) Recruitment (Fifth Amendment) Rules, 1966.
2. In the Schedule to the All India Radio (Class III Posts) Recruitment Rules, 1964, S. Nos. 41 relating to the post of ‘Telecine Operator’, 42 relating to the post of ‘Foreman’ and 43 relating to Posts of ‘Investigator’ shall respectively be re-numbered as S. No. 42, 43 and 44.
