G.S.R. 655.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution, the President hereby makes the following rules to amend the Press Information Bureau (Class III Posts) Recruitment Rules, 1963, published with the notification of the Government of India in the Ministry of Information and Broadcasting, No. G.S.R. 1515, dated the 13th September 1963, namely:—

1. These rules may be called the Press Information Bureau (Class III posts) Recruitment Amendment Rules, 1964.

2. In the Press Information Bureau (Class III posts) Recruitment Rules, 1963, after rule 6, the following rule shall be added, namely:—

“7. *Power to relax.*—Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may by order, for reasons to be recorded in writing, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.”
