सा० का० वि० 2225.—केन्द्रीय सचिवालय सेवा नियम, 1962 के नियम 13 के उपनिबन्ध (9) के अन्वय में, मंत्रिमंडल सचिवालय का कार्मिक और प्रशासनिक सुधार विभाग केन्द्रीय सचिवालय सेवा अनुभाग अधिकारी श्रेणी (प्रतियोगिता परीक्षा) विनियम, 1966 में और संशोधन करने के लिये निम्नलिखित विनियम अनायास है अर्थात्—

1 (1) इन विनियमों का नाम केन्द्रीय सचिवालय सेवा अनुभाग अधिकारी श्रेणी (प्रतियोगिता परीक्षा) (द्वितीय संशोधन) विनियम, 1975 है।

(2) ये राजपत्र में प्रकाशन की तारीख को प्रवृत्त होंगे।

2 केन्द्रीय सचिवालय सेवा अनुभाग अधिकारी, श्रेणी (प्रतियोगिता परीक्षा) विनियम, 1966 में, विनियम 8 में, उपविनियम (1) के स्थान पर निम्नलिखित उपविनियम रखा जाएगा अर्थात्—

G.S.R. 2225.—In pursuance of sub-rule (9) of rule 13 of the Central Secretariat Service Rules, 1962, the Department of Personnel and Administrative Reforms, Cabinet Secretariat, hereby makes the following regulations further to amend the Central Secretariat Service Section Officers' Grade (Competitive Examination) Regulations, 1966, namely—

1 (1) These regulations may be called the Central Secretariat Service Section Officers' Grade (Competitive Examination) (Second Amendment) Regulations, 1975

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the official Gazette

2 In regulations 8 of the Central Secretariat Service Section Officers' Grade (Competitive Examination) Regulations, 1966, for sub-regulation (1) the following sub-regulation shall be substituted namely:—

“(1) Success at the examination shall confer no right to appointment to the Section Officers' Grade of the Service unless the Central Government is

G.S.R. 2260.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution, the President hereby makes the following rules further to amend the All India Radio (Class I posts) Recruitment Rules, 1963, namely :—

1. (1) These rules may be called the All India Radio (Class I Posts) Recruitment (Second Amendment) Rules, 1975.
- (2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. In the All India Radio (Class I posts) Recruitment Rules, 1963 :—

(i) proviso (1) to rule 4 shall be omitted;

(ii) after rule 6, the following rule shall be inserted, namely :—

“7. Saving—Nothing in these rules shall affect reservations and other concessions required to be provided for candidates belonging to the Scheduled Castes, the scheduled Tribes and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard;

(iii) in the schedule, after Serial No. 22 and the entries relating thereto the following serial number and entries shall be substituted namely :—
