- 5.1.8 To participate in the e-bid, it is mandatory for the Applicants to get themselves registered with the Prasar Bharati e-Tendering Portal (https://prasarbharati.eproc.in) to have a user ID & Password which has to be obtained by submitting a non-refundable annual registration charges of Rs.450/-plus 18% GST through online mode (netbanking/debitcard/credit card). Preamble

WHEREAS, the BUYER proposes to procure Services of Transport Facilities on 24x7 basis for local and outstation travel of staff/employees, hereinafter referred as "Tender

AND WHEREAS the BIDDER/ SELLER is a company incorporated in India under Companies Act, 1956/2013 or a Partnership registered under Indian Partnership Act, 1932 or a Limited Liability Partnership (LLP) in India or Government undertaking or a Government Autonomous body and the BUYER is an Autonomous Organisation of the Government of India performing its functions on behalf of the President of India.

AND WHEREAS, the BUYER has appointed Independent External Monitors (IEMs) to monitor the TENDER process and to execute the CONTRACT in compliance with the principles as laid down in this INTEGRITY PACT.

AND WHEREAS to meet the purpose aforesaid both the parties have agreed to enter into this INTEGRITY PACT, the terms and conditions of which shall also be read as integral part of the TENDER document and CONTRACT between the parties.

NOW, THEREFORE,

To avoid all forms of corruption by following a system i.e. fair, transparent and free from any influence / prejudiced dealing prior to, during and subsequent to the currency of the CONTRACT to be entered into with a view to:-

Enable the BUYER to obtain the Services of 24x7 Transport Facilities for DD News on Daily/Monthly basis at a competitive price in conformity with the defined specifications by avoiding the high cost and distortionary impact of corruption on public procurement,

And

To enable the BIDDER/ SELLER to abstain from bribing or indulging in any corrupt practices in order to secure the CONTRACT by providing assurance to the BUYER that their competitors will also abstain from bribing and other corrupt practices,

And

Enable the BUYER to prevent corruption in any form, by its officials by following transparent procedures.

The parties hereto hereby agree to enter into this INTEGRITY PACT and agree as follows:

1. Article 1 – COMMITMENTS OF THE BUYER

- 1.1 The BUYER undertakes that no official of BUYER, connected directly or indirectly with the CONTRACT/ TENDER or the BUYER personally or any of his family members will demand, take a promise for or accept, directly or through intermediaries, any bribe, consideration, gift, reward, favor or any material or immaterial benefit or any other advantage from the BIDDER/ SELLER, either for themselves or for any person, organization or third party related to the CONTRACT in exchange for an advantage in the bidding process, bid evaluation, contracting or implementation process related to the CONTRACT.
- 1.2BUYER will, during the pre-contract stage, treat all BIDDERS alike, and will provide to all BIDDERS the same information and will not provide any such information to any particular BIDDER/ SELLER, which could afford an advantage to that particular BIDDER in comparison to the other BIDDERS.
- 1.3 The officials of the BUYER will report to the Independent External Monitor (IEM) with a copy to the Chief Vigilance Officer (CVO) any attempted or completed breaches of the above commitments as well as any substantial suspicion of such a breach.
- 1.4 In case any such misconduct on the part of such official(s) of the BUYER is reported by the BIDDER to the BUYER with the full and verifiable facts and the same is prima facie found to be correct by the BUYER, necessary disciplinary proceedings, or any other action as deemed fit, including criminal proceedings may be initiated by the BUYER and such a person shall be debarred from further dealings related to the CONTRACT process. In such a case, while an enquiry is being conducted by the BUYER, the proceedings under the CONTRACT would not be stalled, unless considered necessary.

2. Article 2 - COMMITMENTS OF THEBIDDER

- 2.1 The BIDDER commits himself to take all measures necessary to prevent corrupt practices, unfair means and illegal activities during any stage of the bidding or during any pre- contract or post-contract stage in order to secure the CONTRACT or in furtherance to secure it and in particular commits himself to the following:-
- 2.1.1 The BIDDER will not offer, directly or through intermediaries, any bribe, gift, consideration, reward, favor, any material or immaterial benefit or other advantage, commission, fees, brokerage or inducement to any official or family member of the BUYER, connected directly or indirectly with the Biding Process, or to any person, organization or third party related to the CONTRACT in exchange for any advantage in the bidding, evaluation, contracting and implementation of the contract.
- 2.1.2 The BIDDER further undertakes that it has not given, offered or promised to give, directly or indirectly any bribe, gift, consideration, reward, favor, any

material or immaterial benefit or other advantage, commission, fees, brokerage, or inducement to any official of the BUYER or family member of the BUYER or otherwise in procuring the CONTRACT or forbearing to do or having done any act in relation to the obtaining or execution of the CONTRACT or any other CONTRACT with the Prasar Bharati for showing or forbearing to show favor or disfavor to any person in relation to the CONTRACT or any other CONTRACT with Prasar Bharati.

- 2.1.3 BIDDER shall disclose the name and address of his agents and representatives and the Indian BIDDERS shall disclose his foreign principals or associates, if any.
- 2.1.4 BIDDER shall disclose the payments to be made by them to agents/ brokers or any other intermediaries, in connection with this TENDER/CONTRACT.
- 2.1.5 The BIDDER will not collude with other parties interested in the CONTRACT to impair the transparency, fairness and progress of the bidding process, bid evaluation, contracting and implementation of the CONTRACT.
- 2.1.6 The BIDDER will not accept any advantage in exchange for any corrupt practice, unfair means and illegal activities.
- 2.1.7 The BIDDER shall not use impropriety, for purpose of competition or personal gain, or pass on to others, any information provided by BUYER as part of the business relationship, regarding plans, technical proposal and business details, including information contained in any electronic data carrier. The BIDDER also undertakes to exercise due and adequate care lest any such information is divulged.
- 2.1.8 The BIDDER commits to refrain from giving any complaint directly or through any other manner without supporting it with full and verifiable facts.
- 2.1.9 The BIDDER shall not instigate or cause to instigate any third person to commit any of the actions mentioned above in the sub clause of this Article 2.
- 2.1.10 If the BIDDER or any employee of the BIDDER or any person acting on behalf of the BIDDER, either directly or indirectly, is a relative of any of the officers of the BUYER, or alternatively, if any relative of an official of the BUYER has financial interest/stake in the BIDDER's firm, the same shall be disclosed by the BIDDER at the time of filling of tender.
- 2.1.11 The term, relative "for this purpose would be as defined in Section 2(77) of the Companies Act, 2013".
- 2.1.12 The BIDDER shall not lend or borrow any money or enter into any monetary dealings or transactions, directly or indirectly, with any employee of the BUYER.

3. Article 3 - PREVIOUS TRANSGRESSION, IF ANY, OF THE BIDDER

3.1 The BIDDER declares that no previous transgression has occurred in the last three years immediately before signing of this INTEGRITY PACT with any other company in any country in respect of any corrupt practices envisaged hereunder

- or with any Public Sector Enterprise in India or any Government Department in India that could justify BIDDER's exclusion from the TENDER process.
- **3.2**The BIDDER agrees that if it makes incorrect statement on this subject, he can be disqualified from the TENDER process or the CONTRACT, if already awarded, can be terminated for such reason.
- 3.3 If the BIDDER can prove that he has resorted/ recouped the damage caused by him and has installed suitable corruption prevention system, the BUYER may, at his own discretion, as per laid down organisational procedures, revoke the exclusion prematurely.

4. Article 4 - SANCTIONS FOR VIOLATIONS

- **4.1** Any breach of the aforesaid provisions by the BIDDER or any one employed by it or acting on its behalf (whether with or without the knowledge of the BIDDER) shall entitle the BUYER to take all or any one of the following actions, wherever required:-
- **4.1.1** To immediately call off the pre-contract negotiations without assigning any reason or giving any compensation to the BIDDER. However, the proceedings with the other BIDDER(S) would continue.
- **4.1.2** The Earnest Money Deposit (in pre-contract stage) and/or Security Deposit/ Performance Bond (after the CONTRACT is signed) shall stand forfeited either fully or partially, as decided by the BUYER and the BUYER shall not be required to assign any reason there for.
- **4.1.3** To immediately cancel the CONTRACT, if already signed, without giving any compensation to the BIDDER.
- **4.1.4** To cancel all or any other contracts with the BIDDER. The BIDDER shall be liable to pay compensation for any loss or damage to the BUYER resulting from such cancellation/ rescission and the BUYER shall be entitled to deduct the amount so payable from the money(s) due to the BIDDER
- **4.1.5** To debar the BIDDER from participating in future bidding processes of the Government of India/ BUYER for one to three years, which may be further extended at the discretion of the BUYER.
- **4.1.6** To recover all sums paid in violation of this INTEGRITY PACT by the BIDDER to any middlemen or agent or broker with a view to securing the CONTRACT.
- 4.1.7 The BUYER will be entitled to take all or any of the actions mentioned at Paras 4.1.1 to 4.1.6. of this INTEGRITY PACT also on the Commission by the BIDDER or any one employed by it or acting on its behalf (whether with or without the knowledge of the BIDDER), of an offence as defined in Chapter IX of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 or Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988 or any other statute enacted for prevention of corruption.
- 4.1.8 The decision of BUYER to the effect that a breach of the provisions of this INTEGRITY PACT has been committed by the BIDDER shall be final and

conclusive on the BIDDER. However, the BIDDER can approach the IEM(s) appointed for the purposes of this INTEGRITYPACT.

5. Article 5 - LAW AND PLACE OFJURISDICTION

This Pact is subject to Indian Law. The place of performance and jurisdiction is the seat of the BUYER.

6. Article 6 - OTHER LEGAL PROVISIONS/ACTIONS

- **6.1** The actions stipulated in this Integrity Pact are without prejudice to any other legal action that may follow in accordance with the provisions of the extent law in force relating to any civil or criminal proceedings.
- **6.2** Any dispute or difference arising between the parties with regard to the terms of this INTEGRITY PACT and / or, any action taken by the BUYER in accordance with this INTEGRITY PACT or interpretation thereof shall not be subject to arbitration.
- **6.3** Both the parties agree that this INTEGRITY PACT has precedence over the TENDER/ CONTRACT documents with regard to any of the provisions covered under this INTEGRITYPACT.

7. Article 7 -VALIDITY

- 7.1 The validity of this INTEGRITY PACT shall be w.e.f. the date of its signing and will remain effective till the completion the CONTRACT to the satisfaction of both the BUYER and the BIDDER. For unsuccessful BIDDERs at the tendering / precontract stage, this INTEGRITY PACT shall expire after six(06) months from the date of signing of the CONTRACT.
- 7.2 Should one or several provisions of this INTEGRITY PACT turn out to be invalid; the remainder of this Integrity Pact shall remain valid. In this case, the Parties will strive to come to an agreement to their original intentions.

- 7.2 "SERVICES" shall mean the services offered or provided by the Seller such as IT Professional Services, Manpower Services, Security Services, Transport Services, etc. The term 'Service' shall also include supply of goods / articles which are incidental or consequential to the provisioning of such Services as defined in the scope of supply given in the contract.
- 7.3 "SERVICE LEVEL AGREEMENT (SLA)" shall mean the Contractual Commitment that prevails between the Buyer and the Service Provider with regard to type of service to be provided, deliverables, desired performance level, reliability and responsiveness, monitoring process and service level reporting, response and issue resolution time-frame, repercussions / penalties / remedies for service provider not meeting its commitment. The SLA of a particular contract may carry the matrix regarding the delivery of the goods and/or services and the corresponding penalties or remedies and liquidated damages as applicable.
- 7.4 "Buyer" herewith represents DD News
- 7.5 "Service Provider" shall mean any legal entity such as firm /LPP/Private Ltd/Proprietorship etc providing service to the Buyer.
- 7.6 "Service Provider" shall be solely responsible for the Services including, quantity, quality of vehicles provided.

- 7.8 No payment shall be made for rejected services. The penalty imposed in which case shall be in accordance with the penalty clause as per 9.35 of the bid documents.
- 7.9 Delivery Period: The delivery of vehicles shall be in time. Any failure to provide vehicles in stipulated time shall amount to non-delivery of the service and shall attract penalty as per clause 9.35 of the bid document.
- 7.10 Dispute resolution: In the event of any question, dispute or difference arising connection with the Contract, the Parties shall use their respective reasonable endeavour to settle any dispute amicably.
- 7.11 Any dispute by one Party to the other, the same shall be resolved through the mechanism of a Co-ordination Committee to be formed by the Buyer along with representatives from Buyer Department and Seller.

- 7.12 ARBITRATION: In the event of any question, dispute or difference arising under the terms and conditions of the contract, the same shall be referred to the sole arbitration by an officer nominated as Arbitrator by the Buyer. The award of the arbitrator shall be final and binding on the parties to the contract. The arbitration shall be governed as per Indian Arbitration and Conciliation Act 1996 as amended from time to time.

In no event will either party's aggregate liability arising out of or in connection with this agreement or any breach hereof (whether under a theory of contract, (including negligence), warranty or otherwise exceed the Contract Price entered into the Contract between Buyer and Seller.

- 9.5 The travel/transport requirements of DD News shall include, inter-alia, picking-up and dropping of officers/shift-duty staff from and to their residences round-the-clock; travelling between office and the actual place of field duty/coverage's; transportation of coverage equipment; travelling between office and place of official meetings/conferences/seminars/functions etc; travelling to and from airports/railway stations; any other travel requirement including outstation travel requirements.
- 9.6 Bidders who have more than five years of experience in the field and have been providing Transport Services to Government Offices/PSUs/PSEs/Private Entities during last three years and have also executed one single simlar contarct (providing service 24X7) of value Rs 4 Cr.(Approx.) in the year 2020-21, having their registered office in Delhi can apply for the bid.
- 9.7 Bidders shall have average annual turnover to the tune of Rs. 5 Crores in last three years i.e. 2018-19, 2019-20 and 2020-21.
- 9.8 Bidders shall have provided 70% of the vehicles sought in the Tender for at least a year during the past three year to Government Entities or should have provided at least 50% of vehicles each to two different Government entities during the same period.
- 9.9 Payment to the Services provided shall be made on a monthly basis.
- 9.10 The contract between the Buyer and the Service Provider shall be valid for a period of two years, extendable for another two year on the satisfactory performance of the agency. DD News reserves the right to curtail or extend the validity of contract on the same rates, terms and conditions.

- 9.11 Only those Service Providers, who are based in Delhi and have a registered office in Delhi, and who fulfill the eligibility conditions mentioned in the bid document, shall be eligible to participate in the tendering.
- 9.12 Each tenderer shall be required to commit the requisite number of taxi-cars and/or taxi-SUVs along with drivers on payroll as sought in case he is finally selected.
- 9.13 The Service Provider shall also be required to provide additional vehicles up to 25% of the Contracted vehicles on any day on demand basis.
- 9.14 To ensure the safety of staff member's especially female, proper GPS system should be available in all the vehicles provided by the Service Provider as per the norms laid down by the Delhi Government from time to time. GPS data should be made available to DD News as and when required. An undertaking in this regard shall be given by the bidder(s) at the time of agreement.
- 9.15 All costs, damages or expenses, which the DD News may have paid or which under the contract the Service Provider is liable, are to be deducted and recovered by the DD News from money due or becoming due to the Service Provider from the DD News by action of law or otherwise from the Service Provider. In the event of recovery of the necessary extent becoming impossible, owing to in-sufficient security money and otherwise held amounts, the balance due to the DD News may be recovered in any manner the DD News may deem fit.
- 9.16 If the transporter is directly or indirectly, found to be involved in fraudulent and collusive practices they may be black listed for a period of up to 3 years. If the Service Provider fails to complete the work within stipulated period specified in the work order, they are liable to be debarred or black listed from participating in future tender of DD News for the period ranging from 1 to 3 years. In case tenderer amends/modifies/revised/withdraws the prices/price structure of the offer without the consent of DD News after the tender opening and during the period of validity of their offer (i.e.120 days), the Earnest Money in full or part deposited by them shall be liable to be forfeited or their offer is liable to be rejected. They shall also be debarred from participating in future tenders of DD News for a period upto 3 years and shall be placed under Black List.
- 9.17 The successful bidders shall meet the transport requirements of DD News round-the-clock, as per the requisitions made by the transport in-charge and/or any other officer authorized by DD News from time-to-time. The Service Provider shall always ensure punctual deployment of taxi-cars/taxi-vans to DD News as and when requisitioned by the transport-in-charge and/or any other officer authorized by DD News.
- 9.18 The Service Provider shall ensure that the Vehicles deployed on hire to the Doordarshan News are in excellent working condition, engine-wise as well as appearance-wise. The Concerned Transporter (s) shall also ensure that the speedometers of such Vehicles are in perfect working order and sealed. The

accuracy of meter reading should tally with the actual distance of run at any point of time and controlling / authorized officer shall have full power to check the meter for its correctness and to take action to recover the actual loss to Doordarshan News. The following are also required:

- 9.18.1 All the drivers shall be in the payroll of the Service Provider.
- 9.18.2 The Drivers of the vehicles should be well dressed in Uniform.
- 9.18.3 The vehicle should be neat and clean every time and the quality seat covers should be maintained.
- 9.18.4 The transporter shall not employ any person/ driver who has not completed 18 years of age.
- 9.18.5 The contractor shall comply with all statutory provisions as laid down under various Labour Law/Acts/Rules like minimum wages, Provident Fund, ESI, Bonus, Gratuity, Contract Labour Act and other Labour Laws/Acts/Rules in force from time to time at his own cost. In case of violation of any such statutory provisions under Labour Laws or any other laws by the transporter, there will not be any liability on DD News.
- 9.18.6 The Driver should wear a proper Dress and the Vehicles should be neat and clean by changing the seat covers etc from time to time. If any time it is found that the Driver is not in the uniform/dress and the vehicle is untidy, penalty as mentioned will be imposed on the monthly invoice.
- 9.18.7 DD News will be under no legal obligation to provide employment to any of the personnel of the contractor after the expiry of the Contract period and the department recognizes no employer-employee relationship with the personnel deployed by the contractor / agency.
- 9.19 Any person who is in Government Service or an employee of DD News should not be associated with the transporter directly or indirectly in any manner whatsoever.
- 9.20 The transporter shall indemnify the DD News against all other damages/charges for which the Government/Department may be held liable or pay on account of the negligence of the transporter or his staff or any person under his control whether in respect of accident/injury to the person or damages to the property of any member of the public or any person or in executing the work or otherwise and against all claims and demand thereof. The DD News shall not be responsible financially or otherwise for any injury to the driver or person deployed by the contractor during the course of performing the duties.
- 9.21 The successful Transporter(s) shall ensure that all the drivers deployed in the hired Vehicles to the Doordarshan News have good knowledge of routes in Delhi and are well dressed in proper uniform, well trained, well behaved, punctual and possessing valid driving license, badge and mobile phone. The successful Transporter(s) shall further ensure that no such driver is under the influence of alcohol or any intoxicating drugs while on duty with the Doordarshan News. Only

- experienced driver(s) with minimum 5 years' experience and valid driving license shall be provided.
- 9.22 Under no circumstances, a driver without valid license shall be allowed to drive the vehicle. The Service Provider has to undertake proper police verification for character antecedents of each driver and produce the same to DD News. The Service Provider should ensure that all security instructions issued by the Competent Authority from time to time are being followed.
- 9.23 The drivers shall not be entitled to any scheduled and/or fixed breaks for lunch, tea, dinner or any other refreshments. In other words, for such purposes, the drivers shall have to manage from within the time available in between any particular two journeys without causing inconvenience of any kind to the officer(s) concerned. Also, no mileage (extra) shall be allowed to the drivers for such purposes.
- 9.24 The Doordarshan News shall have the absolute right not to accept a particular driver without assigning any reason, whatsoever, to the Service Provider. The Service Provider on its/their part(s) shall be responsible to replace such a driver at once.
- 9.25 In case of any breakdown of a particular Vehicle deployed on hire to the Doordarshan News during the course of a particular journey, the Concerned Transporter (s) shall bear the actual cost incurred by the Doordarshan News to complete that particular journey by alternative means of equivalent standard. The Service Provider shall also be responsible to provide replacement of such brokendown Vehicles at once.
- 9.26 The Service Provider shall be fully responsible in case of any violation of traffic rules(s) by the drivers of the Vehicles deployed on hire to the Doordarshan News as also in the event of any loss, damage or accident involving such Vehicles. The Doordarshan News shall have no liability, whatsoever, in this regard.
- 9.27 The Service Provider shall be fully responsible for any loss, damage or injury to any person, their belongings and/or any equipment being transported by the Doordarshan News in the Vehicles deployed on hire.
- 9.28 The Service Provider shall ensure that each and every Vehicle deployed on hire to the Doordarshan News is covered by an appropriate comprehensive insurance policy.

9.29 Penalty-Clause:

9.29.1 In case, the Service Provider fails to deploy the actual number of Vehicles required by the Doordarshan News on a particular day/occasion, the Doordarshan News shall be free to make alternate arrangements of equivalent standard from other sources. The entire and actual cost incurred by the Doordarshan News on making such alternative arrangements shall be fully borne by the Service Provider without any reference to the hire charges applicable under the contract with him.

- 9.29.2 In case, full service or part of the service is rejected by the Buyer due to substandard quality on a particular day/occasion, Doordarshan News shall be free to make alternate arrangements of equivalent standard from other sources. The entire and actual cost incurred by the Doordarshan News on making such alternative arrangements shall be fully borne by the Service Provider without any reference to the hire charges applicable under the contract with him.
- 9.29.3 In case, a vehicle is delayed by more than 15 minutes, a penalty shall be levied at the rate of 200 percent of the hour rate for deployment for the delayed period, on pro rata basis, excluding force.
- 9.29.4 Penalty of Rs.1000/- will be imposed if the vehicle is untidy or the driver is not in uniform. If the driver is not in uniform and the vehicle is untidy then Rs 2000/- will be imposed for that particular vehicle.
- 9.29.5 In case the Service Provider fails to provide the vehicle on any day(s), the recovery @ double the awarded rate per day shall be effected from the running bills.
- 9.29.6 Safety Measures- Service Provider shall ensure that safety rules are observed to avoid any accident which may cause loss of life to Service Provider or DD News Staff and damage to DD News property. In case of violation of these Safety Instructions Safety Codes and applicable Act & Rules, which are necessary to ensure safety of men, material, environment and equipment, or Service Provider's willful failure to comply with the instructions of DD News, the latter shall impose a penalty of Rs.1500/- (Rs. Fifteen Hundred Only).
- 9.29.7 Maximum penalty that can be imposed shall not exceed 10% of the monthly charges for the Service Provided.
- 9.30 The successful bidder shall ensure that proper account of each journey made by the Vehicle deployed on hire to the Doordarshan News is maintained by the respective drivers and submitted to the transport-in-charge of the Doordarshan News at the end of a particular day. Log sheet of every vehicle should be certified by the actual users on daily basis.
- 9.31 The driver along with vehicle will have to report at place as desired by vehicle user 15 minutes before pre-intimated time.
- 9.32 In case, the vehicles are being hired on monthly basis including Sundays & holidays, the Service Provider will not change the driver / vehicle frequently to that particular user, unless change is requested by the user.
- 9.33 In case vehicle is not provided on any day, recovery as mentioned in penalty clause for not providing vehicle shall be recovered from vendor's bill.
- 9.34 The monthly fixed charges should be inclusive of all overhead charges like fuel, Lubricant, taxes, comprehensive insurance, payment to staff/drivers, vehicle maintenance, etc., if a vehicle is plying on monthly basis for 12 hours. However, if the vehicle is detained beyond 12 hours, extra charge per hour will be paid.

- 9.35 The Service Provider should have full knowledge of Indian Motor Vehicles Act and Rules made there under from time to time and Service Provider shall remain responsible for any lapse of not following such Rules during the tenure of contract.
- 9.36 The Service Provider shall make own arrangement for stay of his driver/staff. Service Provider will be responsible for all kinds of injuries or accident caused to his driver/staff and DD News will not be liable in this regard.
