G.S.R. 346.—In exercise of the powers conferred by clause (b) of sub-section (3) of section 1 of the Employees' Provident Funds Act, 1952 (19 of 1952), the Central Government hereby applies the said Act, with effect from the 30th April, 1962, to every trading and commercial establishment employing twenty or more persons each and engaged in the purchase, sale or storage of any goods, including establishments of exporters, importers, advertisers, commission agents and brokers, and commodity and stock exchanges, but not including banks or ware-houses established under any Central or State Act.

MINISTRY OF INFORMATION & BROADCASTING

G.S.R. 347.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution, and in supersession of the Broadcasting Stations, All India Radio Recruitment Rules, 1958, published with the notification of the Government of India in the Ministry of Information and Broadcasting No. S.O. No. 1369, dated 9th May, 1959, the President hereby makes the following rules, namely:—

1. **Short title.**—These rules may be called the All India Radio (Class II Posts) Recruitment Rules, 1962.

2. **Application.**—These rules shall apply for recruitment to the posts specified in column 2 of the Schedule to these rules.

3. **Number of posts, classification and scale of pay.**—The number and classification of the posts and the scale of pay attached thereto shall be as specified in columns 3, 4 and 5 of the said Schedule.

4. **Nature, method of recruitment, age limits and qualifications etc.**—The nature of the posts, age limits, qualifications, method of recruitment and other matters connected therewith shall be as specified in columns 6 to 14 of the aforesaid Schedule:

- (1) Provided that the age limits specified in Column 7 of the said Schedule may be relaxed in the case of candidates belonging to the Scheduled Castes or Scheduled Tribes and other special categories in accordance with the general instructions issued by the Central Government from time to time;
- (2) Provided further that the educational and other qualifications specified in Column 8 of the said Schedule may be relaxed by the Ministry of Information and Broadcasting on the recommendations of the Union Public Service Commission in the case of a candidate considered otherwise suitable for appointment to a post specified in Column 2 of the aforesaid Schedule;
- (3) Provided also that the posts required to be filled by promotion may be filled by direct recruitment if no suitable candidate is available for appointment thereto by promotion.

5. **Probation.**—All persons appointed whether by direct recruitment or otherwise to the posts specified in Column 2 of the aforesaid Schedule shall be on probation for a period of two years.

6. **Disqualification.**—(a) No person who has more than one wife living or who having a spouse living, marries in any case in which such marriage is void by reasons of its taking place during the life time of such spouse, shall be eligible for appointment to the service;

(b) No woman whose marriage is void by reasons of the husband having a wife living at the time of such marriage or who has married a person who had a wife living at the time of such marriage, shall be eligible for appointment to service;

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that there are special grounds for so ordering, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

(c) No candidate who is admitted in the written test *cum* interview for appointment against direct recruitment quota of 75 per cent specified in Column

of the Schedule, under the age concession admissible to Government servants specified in Column 7 of the Schedule, will be eligible for appointment, if after submitting the application, he resigns from service either before or after taking the written test *cum* interview.
