

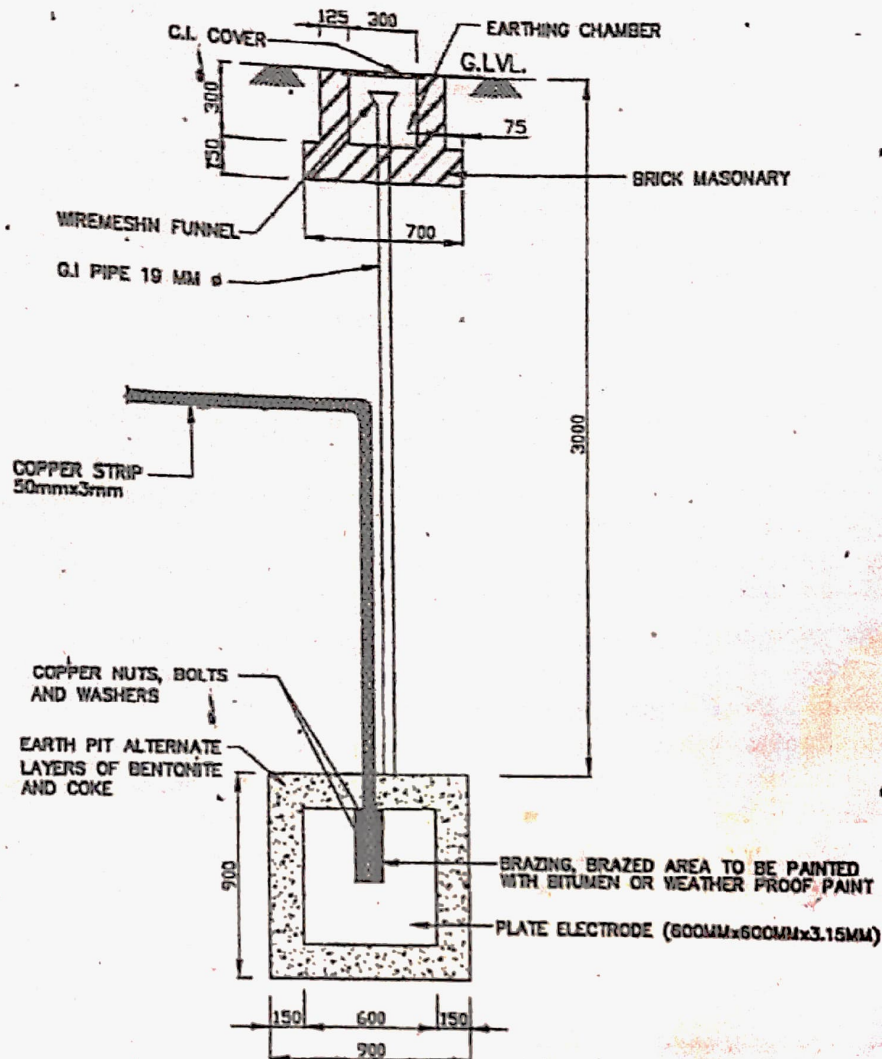

Name of the Work: Supply, fabrication and construction of copper plate earth pits- 02 Nos. having earth resistance of less than 1 ohm, as per the details given below:-

Pit size of 1000mm x 1000mm (at bottom) x 10ft. deep (or more) is to be excavated & Copper plate of Size 600x600x3 mm is to be placed vertically in the excavated Pit. The plate shall be connected to copper strip of 25mmx3mmx5 mtr. length by brazing and using brass bolts, nuts, check nuts & washers. Copper purity should be of 99.9%. The pit to be filled with alternate layers of 80kgs of charcoal & 80kgs. of raw salt in alternate layers up to a depth of 900 mm & remaining portion to be filled with fresh loose soil without stones preferably black cotton soil. The job includes providing of 1½' x1½'x1' (height) elevated brick chamber at ground level with neat finish/plastering with a hole in the middle to pass the 10ft. long Class B G.I. pipe of 48 mm dia. having minimum 10mm holes at every 6" length with a provision for funnel at the top. The funnel shall be fixed with wire mesh. The chamber to be provided with FRP/G.I. manhole frame & cover.

COPPER PLATE EARTHING



NOTE:-

1. PIT SIZE OF 900x900x3900(or more) MM IS EXCAVATED & COPPER PLATE OF SIZE 600x600x3.15 MM IS PLACED VERTICALLY IN THE EXCAVATED PIT. THE PLATE SHALL BE CONNECTED TO COPPER STRIP OF 50x3 MM. THE BOLTS, NUTS, CHECK NUTS & WASHERS SHALL BE OF COPPER. THE PIT IS FILLED WITH ALTERNATE LAYERS OF COKE & BENTONITE UP TO A DEPTH OF 900 MM & REMAINING PORTION FILLED WITH LOOSE SOIL WITHOUT STONES. THE MASONRY CHAMBER AT GROUND LEVEL OF SIZE 700x700x450 MM WITH A HOLE IN MIDDLE TO PASS THE G.I. PIPE OF 19 MM DIA WITH A PROVISION FOR FUNNEL & PROVIDED WITH C.I. FRAME & COVER WITH LOCKING ARRANGEMENTS. THE FUNNEL SHALL BE FIXED WITH WIRE MESH. THE MAIN HOLE COVER SHALL BE PAINTED & MARKED WITH RESISTANCE OF THE EARTH.

1. The firm although as per tender are required to quote the rates with validity for three months from date of award of tender.
2. The firm/company must be registered as a firm or as a company with the Registrar of Firms or Registrar of Companies & GST registration is must for Participation in tender.
3. The firms are desired to submit on line all documents like PAN /GST registration, their company profile and proof of availability of office/ware house in Delhi NCR.
4. The scopes of work or stores to be tendered are available in the complete bid documents which can be viewed or downloaded from e-tender portal of <https://prasarbharati.eproc.in>. & <https://prasarbharati.gov.in/pbtenders/>. Both Technical Bid and Financial Bid will be submitted concurrently duly digitally signed in the website <https://prasarbharati.eproc.in>. No claim shall be entertained on account of disruptions of internet service being used by bidders. Bidders are advised to upload their bids well in advance to avoid last minute technical snags.
5. All Corrigendum / Amendment/Corrections, if any, will be published on the website <https://prasarbharati.eproc.in>. All documents/papers uploaded submitted by the bidder must be legible. It is mandatory for all the applicants to have Class-III Digital Signature Certificate (in the name of person who will sign the bid document) from any of the licensed certifying. To participate in the e-tendering submission, it is mandatory for the applicants to get registered their firm/joint venture with the e- tendering portal of <https://prasarbharati.eproc.in> to have user ID & Password from M/s C1 India Pvt. 1. Bid document contains certain conditions for Manual submission of tender and are now redundant. Document shall be deemed to have been modified to that extent. Page No. shall be given on each and every paper/documents serially uploaded in the technical by bidders, Bidders shall ensure to quote rate of each item. If any cell is left blank and no rate is quoted the rate of such item shall be treated as "0" (zero). The Earnest Money shall be in the form of ST ENG PBBCI DD KUBAND EARTHST payable at New Delhi. However exemption we will be given to the firms registered with MSME.
2. The items / facilities desired for short duration (2-6 days) absolutely on hire as per norms enlisted under DGS&D and other applicable /accepted Norms of Government of India and amended time to time.
3. The duly authorized committee by competent authority may like to inspect the warehouse (s) and/ or other places (s) as identified by the entity for getting inspected the facilities and equipment before finalization of technical evaluation process of received bids.
4. The operators / essential crew members must be the minimum, restricted to quantity that is fully mandatory and absolutely essential for full operation of hired equipment. The personal should be properly trained and have sufficient experience and exposure in related field in major international/ national events. The operators / crew members should be at the sole responsibility of bidder firm and his contract with firm should be abiding to the applicable labor laws of the Republic of India. Doordarshan shall in no way be legally responsible for any compensation/imposition of penalty in case of non-compliance of labor laws by firm (bidder) or any payment of any kind relating to minimum wages or permanent employment. Any such act by firm (bidder) shall necessarily amount to termination of contract with seizure of all payments and black listing from future bidding. All requisite verification and clearances for such deputed personnel i.e. police verification; travel documents, etc. are to be provided by firm (bidder) on demand during any deployment of hired facility on advance intimation.
5. The firm shall be solely responsible if the Hired equipment gets damaged during its usual predefined usage as per its manual or due to mishandling by its operator provided by firm or due to any unnatural calamity or act of God. In all such case the firm (Bidder) cannot file any case of Arbitration for compensation of any kind on Doordarshan. No compensation will hence be made for the equipment damaged during the time of coverage/recordings or at the time of transportation whatsoever may be the reasons. However if during the regular, scheduled use of Hired facility there is loss to camera/Manpower of Doordarshan due to poor workmanship or manufacturing defect in Hired equipment the firm shall be liable to give compensation as per Independent internal enquiry committee setup by Doordarshan or Legal proceeding in Delhi /NCR.
6. In case of any dispute between the successful bidder (firm/company) and Prasar Bharati arising out of in relation to this Contract, the dispute shall be referred to a sole Arbitrator to be appointed by Prasar Bharati. Any decision of such Arbitrator shall be conducive and binding on both the parties. The arbitration proceedings shall be held at Delhi and shall be governed by the provisions of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996, as amended from time to time. The Courts

of Delhi will have jurisdiction over all legal disputes arising out of or in relation to this Contract.

7. The successful bidder shall be required to submit a security deposit/performance guarantee equivalent 3% of Contract value in the form of FDR drawn in favor of DDO, DTH ES Todapur, New Delhi or Bank Guarantee valid for three months within 3 days of the award of the contract. The successful bidder (contractor firm) shall have to enter into an 'Agreement' containing the terms & condition mentioned herein with this office upon award of the contract returnable after completion of the contract to the satisfaction of DD News without any interest for the period it was under deposit. However, the security deposit or Bank Guarantee shall be liable to be forfeited for any deficiency in its services or violation of any provision of the terms & conditions of the contract, by it.
8. **Terms of payment:** NEFT on receipt of valid pre receipt bill with itemized billing with HSN codes to authorized account of bidder. No payment shall be released by cheque. Payment shall be released only after completion of satisfactory services.
9. **Engagement period:** The proposed agreement/order will be for **one month** from contract start date. All inclusive financial quote (s): While putting up the figures in financial bid for proposed service Inspection, Servicing and Preventive Maintenance of 9m Ku Band Transmit-Receive Antenna:
10. The entity has to include necessary provisions for transportation of equipment (in Delhi/ NCR Delhi), installation, de-rig of the equipment/facilities, travel and per Diem of manpower, incidentals charges (if any), etc. No extra charges will be entertained later on. No. separate figure has to be quoted for all these. The financial quote should be inclusive of all such aspects.
11. The Prasar Bharati, New Delhi reserves the right to cancel any or all bids without assigning any reason or accept any bid in part or full.
12. The Prasar Bharati, New Delhi reserves the right to terminate the work order/contract without assigning any reason thereof.
13. The bids not complied with the above shall be summarily rejected. Prices quoted should be for F.O.R. (DTH ES Todapur) and Inclusive of charges as packing customs, etc., wherever applicable. The quotation should specifically mention rates for Supply & Taxes separately. In case of Quotation of F.O.R Station of dispatch basis, the purchaser will not pay separately transit insurance and the supplier will be responsible until the stores arrive in good condition at the destination. Tender/quotation in which transit insurance has been specified as an additional item of expenditure is liable to be ignored.
14. If any tenderer withdraws his tender before the expiry of the validity period, or before the issue of letter of acceptance, whichever is earlier, or makes any modification in Terms and conditions of the tender which are not acceptable to the department, then the Government shall, without prejudice to any other right or remedy, be at liberty to forfeit The earnest money absolutely. This provision would naturally apply only to the lowest tenderer once the earnest money of all the tenderer except those of the lowest is refunded as per provisions.

15. The tender should consist of PRICE BID (Annexure 5) separately and acceptance of terms and condition and should be digitally signed and uploaded on the purchase portal of Prasar Bharati. <https://prasarbharati.eproc.in>.
16. MANUAL/TELEFAX/e-MAIL offers, received directly by this organization, will not be considered. In case tender opening date falls on a holiday, the bids will be received and opened at the same specified time on next working day. Bids received late or submitted after the scheduled specified time on scheduled date will not be entertained and will be returned back unopened.
17. The purchaser may, at his discretion extend the deadline for the submission of the bids by mending the bid document, in which case all rights and obligations of the purchaser and Bidders previously subject to the deadline will thereafter be subject to the deadline as extended.
18. Tenderer can quote for individual line item. Tenderer can quote to as many line items in the Table as he finds appropriate and comfortable in rendering services.
19. Performance Guarantee (**as per Annexure: 4**): Successful Bidder needs to submit Security Deposit of 3% of contract Value only as stated above in the Tender Document.
20. Payment of Entry Tax / Octroi Duty and Toll Tax (on ultimate products): As the material, which is to be transported to the consignee, belongs to the Government of India /Prasar Bharati and therefore is exempted from Entry Tax / Octroi Duty / Toll Tax. However, if the State Governments / Statutory Local Bodies are bound to levy such taxes, the taxes will be paid by supplier / contractor. Supplier / Contractor may raise its claim, for reimbursement of such duties / taxes paid, with Organization, along with original receipt of the payment.
21. GST liable and intended to be claimed from the purchaser should be distinctly shown along with prices quoted. Where this is not done a claim for GST will be admitted at any later stage and on any ground whatsoever.
22. Printed terms and conditions of tendering firms will not be considered as forming parts of their tender.
23. The Bid submitted shall remain open for acceptance for a period of 180 days.
24. **RIGHT OF ACCEPTANCE:** The undersigned reserves the right to reject the lowest tender or all the tenders after assigning reasons whatsoever. Further, the undersigned reserves himself the right to increase or decrease up to 50% of the quantity of goods and services specified in the schedule of the requirement without any change in the unit price of the order quantities or other term conditions at the time of award of contract. All Quotations/Tenders in which any of the prescribed conditions are not fulfilled or are incomplete in any respect are liable to be rejected. The competent authority on behalf of President of India reserves the right of accepting the whole or any part of the Tender shall be bound to perform the same at the rate quoted. Canvassing whether directly or indirectly, in connection with Tender/quotation is strictly prohibited and the Tender/quotation submitted by the Contractors / suppliers who resort to canvassing will be liable to rejection.

25. FAILURE AND TERMINATION CLAUSE

Time and date of delivery shall be essence of the contract. If the Contractor / Supplier fails to deliver the stores, within the period fixed for such delivery in the schedule or at any time repudiates the contract before the expiry of such periods, the purchaser may without prejudice to any other right or remedy, available to him to recover demur-rages for breach of the contract:-

- a. It may further be noted that the liquidated demur rages on the cost of contract price of delayed/No supplies (whole unit) at the rate of 10% of issued order value from outstanding of firm to this office or directly debit able from security deposit with intimation to the firm and liability to be black listed from any further tender in future.
- b. Cancel the contract or a portion there of by serving prior notice to the Contractor/Supplier and if so desired purchase or authorize the purchase of the stores not so delivered not carried out, or others of a similar description (where stores not delivered not carried out, exactly complying with particulars are not in the opinion of the purchaser, which shall be final readily procurable) at the risk and cost of the Contractor/Supplier. If the Contractor/Supplier had defaulted in the performance of the original contract, the purchaser shall have the right to ignore his tender for risk purchase even though the lowest, where the contract is terminated at the risk and cost of the firm under the provisions of this clause, it shall be in the discretion of the purchaser to exercise his discretion to collect or not, the Performance Guarantee from the firm on whom the contract is placed, at the risk and expense of the defaulted firm.

26. FORCE MAJEURE:

- a. If any time during the continuance of the contract the performance in whole or in part by the contractor shall be prevented or delayed by reason of any war, hostility acts of the public enemy. Civil commotion, sabotage, fires, floods, explosions, epidemics, Quarantine restrictions, strikes, lock-outs/lockdown or acts of God (therein after restrictions refer to as events and provided notice of happenings of any such eventuality is given by the contractor within 21 days from the date of occurrence thereof, the purchaser shall by reason of such event, neither be entitled to cancel this order not shall have any claim for damages against the contractor in respect of such non-performance or delay in performance and delivery shall be resumed as soon as practicable after such events have come to an end or ceased to exist.
- b. Provided further that if the performance in whole or part or any obligation under this order is prevented or delayed by reasons of any such event for a period exceeding 180 days, the purchaser and the contractor shall meet to find a neutral agreement to any effect resulting the reform or the purchaser may at his option cancel order provided also if the order is cancelled under this clause, the purchaser shall be at liberty to take over from the contractor at order prices all unused, un- damaged and acceptable

material bought out components and stores in course of manufacture in the possession of the supplier at the time of such cancellation.

27. **CANCELLATION:** The purchaser reserves the right to cancel the order in the event of non-performance/ delay in execution of the work or unsatisfactory performance by the contractor and recover payment already made if any, along with losses/ damages incurred.

28. **GENERAL:** All the pages of the tender document should be duly signed, stamped and serially numbered on submission, failing which the tender may not be considered as qualified tender.

For Consortium / Joint Venture: (If not applicable these clause may deleted)

In case of a Consortium/JV, Power of Attorney issued by Board of Directors/ Chairman/CEO / MD / Company Secretary of the Consortium Lead Member as well as Consortium Member(s) of the Consortium/ partners of JV, in favour of the authorised employee(s) of the Consortium /Lead member of JV, for signing the documents on behalf of the Bidder, in respect of this particular tender, to sign the Bid and all subsequent communications, agreements, documents etc. pertaining to the tender and act and take any and all decisions on behalf of the Consortium/JV, are to be submitted.

The authorized employee(s) of the Bidder shall be signing the Bid and any consequence resulting due to such signing shall be binding on the Bidder.

Bids from consortium/ JV of two or more members (maximum 3 nos. Including Leader) are acceptable provided that they fulfill the qualification criteria and requirements stated in the Tender Documents. Participating Consortium/ JV shall submit the Agreement, clearly defining the scope and responsibility of each member. Members of consortium/ JV shall assume responsibility jointly & severally. The bid security shall be submitted by the Bidder (Consortium/JV). In case of award, payment shall be made to the Consortium/JV.

The Consortium/ JV Agreement must clearly define the Consortium Leader/ Lead Partner of JV, who shall be responsible on behalf of the Consortium/JV during the period of evaluation of the bid as well as during the execution of Contract for timely completion of supply and shall receive/ send instructions for and on behalf of the Consortium/JV..

A Consortium/ JV once established at the time of submitting the Bid shall not be allowed to be altered with respect to constituting members of the Consortium/ JV or their respective roles/ scope of supply/work, except with prior written approval of Prasar Bharati. If during the evaluation of bids, a Consortium/JV propose any alteration/ changes in the orientation of Consortium/JV or replacements or inclusions or exclusions of any partner(s)/ member(s) which had originally submitted the bid, bid from such Bidder shall be liable for rejection.

Any member of the Consortium/ JV shall not be eligible either in an individual capacity or be a part of any other Consortium/JV to participate in this tender.
